

COVID-19 POLICY

Parents will be asked to read and confirm they agree to this policy before their child attends any of our sessions. It is vital we have a signed agreement from you prior to attending. This must be sent electronically back to us via email.

1. We ask all children, parents and coaches, to reschedule sessions if they currently have symptoms consistent with COVID-19, live in a household with somebody with current symptoms or have been in contact with somebody with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 within the last 14 days. Please follow government guidance on isolation. If you have any symptoms of corona virus you should arrange a test by visiting <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/>
2. Socially distanced sessions in place, coaches will not be catching or supporting children at this time, this will mean sessions will focus on the basics working up to skills the child is able to do unsupported.
3. Equipment is laid out as per our National Governing Body guidelines - British Gymnastics.
4. We ask all children in the shielded/vulnerable group to not attend face to face sessions and classes as we are uninsured to coach you.
5. To limit numbers in the building we have scheduled gaps between each training slot and class. Please maintain social distancing before and after sessions.
6. Please leave promptly and do not arrive any sooner than 5 min prior to the session starting. Please line up at the front of the sports centre and our team will meet you and take you in to the hall.
7. We will be following strict social distancing guidelines throughout all sessions.
8. If your child has an accident, or requires first aid we will administer it and this will require close contact. You must agree to this or we cannot offer the session and cannot be held responsible for any Covid risk associated to this. We will of course ensure we minimise risk where possible and all treatment will be provided in full PPE.
9. All Coaches are following guidelines laid down by British Gymnastics & Public Health England.
10. We will be asking all children to wash their hands using the hand sanitiser provided before, during and after each session.
11. You agree to us logging your attendance at all sessions, to be used in trace and track should we be required if someone develops symptoms. You will be logged in via Love Admin for classes.
12. If you are going on holiday and you are subject to new quarantine restrictions you must ensure you let us know and do not attend sessions during this time.
